A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE ACQUISITION OR CONSTRUCTION AND THE

2 3 FINANCING, WITHOUT APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GENERAL FUND, AND TO 4 MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS FOR APPROPRIATIONS RELATED TO 5 CERTAIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS OF THE CONSTITUENT 6 INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.(a)** The purpose of this section is to authorize (i) the acquisition or 9 construction of the capital improvement projects listed in this section for the respective 10 institutions of The University of North Carolina and (ii) the financing of these projects with funds available to the institutions from gifts, grants, receipts, self-liquidating indebtedness, Medicare 11 reimbursements for education costs, hospital receipts from patient care, or other funds, or any 12 13 combination of these funds, but not including funds received for tuition or appropriated from the 14 General Fund of the State unless previously authorized by General Statute.

SECTION 1.(b) The capital improvement projects, and their respective costs, 15 authorized by this section to be acquired or constructed and financed as provided in subsection 16 (a) of this section, including by revenue bonds, by special obligation bonds as authorized in 17 subsection (d) of this section, or by both, are as follows: 18
