- 6 **SECTION 2.(b)** G.S. 130A-115 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
- 7 "(g) Beginning September 1, 2022, death certificates shall be filed electronically with the
- 8 Office of Vital Records via the North Carolina Database Application for Vital Events
- 9 (NCDAVE) system. No individual responsible for the certification of a death pursuant to
- 10 subsection (c) of this section shall fail or refuse to certify the death certificate via the designated
- 11 electronic death registration system. Notwithstanding subsection (f) of this section, any
- 12 individual who willfully and knowingly violates this requirement may be assessed an
- 13 administrative penalty of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) for the first violation, five hundred
- 14 dollars (\$500.00) for the second violation, and one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for the third and
- 15 each subsequent violation."".
