SENATE BILL DRS45085-LG-53B*

Short Title: Adopt Wounded Heroes Day. (Public)

Sponsors: Senator Johnson (Primary Sponsor).

Referred to:

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT ADOPTING THE TWENTY-FOURTH DAY OF APRIL OF EACH YEAR AS
3 WOUNDED HEROES DAY IN HONOR OF ARMY SGT. MICHAEL VERARDO.

4 Whereas, Sgt. Michael Verardo served in the United States Army until receiving a
5 medical retirement in 2013; and

6 Whereas, on April 24, 2010, while on foot patrol as an Infantryman with the 82nd
7 Airborne, Bravo Company (2-508th) Parachute Infantry Regiment, in Afghanistan, Sgt. Verardo
8 was wounded by an improvised explosive device, causing him to lose his left leg and much of
9 his left arm, withstand severe burns, and suffer a traumatic brain injury and other injuries that
10 required a field blood transfusion; and

11 Whereas, Sgt. Verardo bravely endured years of physical, occupational, speech, and
12 visual therapies and, on April 24, 2019, his Ninth Alive Day, underwent his 120th surgery; and

13 Whereas, because of his courage and grit, Sgt. Verardo has overcome unimaginable
14 challenges and obstacles and is now able to enjoy adaptive athletics, such as competitive pistol
15 shooting, and is an active participant in his church and community; and

16 Whereas, in honor of Sgt. Verardo's Alive Day anniversary and in recognition of all
17 the other wounded heroes who have bravely made great sacrifices in service to our nation, it is
18 fitting to designate April 24th of each year as Wounded Heroes Day in North Carolina; Now,
19 therefore,

20 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

21 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 103 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
22 section to read:

23 "**§ 103-16. Wounded Heroes Day.**

24 The twenty-fourth day of April of each year is designated as Wounded Heroes Day in North
25 Carolina."

26 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
