8	(e) for any construction, installation, repair, replacement, or alteration performed in accord	ance
9	with the current edition of the North Carolina State Building Code and costing fifteen thou	
10	dollars (\$15,000) twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) or less in any single family residence	e or
11	farm building unless the work involves any of the following:	
12	(1) The addition, repair, or replacement of load bearing structures. Howeve	
13	permit is required for replacements of windows, doors, exterior siding, o	
14	pickets, railings, stair treads, and decking of porches and exterior decks	that
15	otherwise meet the requirements of this subsection.	
16	(2) The addition or change in the design of plumbing. However, no perm	
17	required for replacements otherwise meeting the requirements of	this
18	subsection that do not change size or capacity.	
19	(3) The addition, replacement or change in the design of heating, air condition	ning,
20	or electrical wiring, appliances, or equipment.	
21	(4) The use of materials not permitted by the North Carolina Residential Cod	e for
22	One- and Two-Family Dwellings.	
23	(5) The addition (excluding replacement) of roofing."	
24	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2021, and applies to	•
25	construction, installation, repair, replacement, or alteration on single family residences or	tarm
26	buildings occurring on or after that date.
