1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 29-31, by rewriting the lines to read: 2 3 For the purposes of this section, a "transient occupancy" is the rental of an "(c) 4 accommodation by an inn, hotel, motel, recreational vehicle park, campground, or similar 5 lodging to the same guest or occupant for fewer than 45 consecutive days. An innkeeper shall provide a guest with written notice at least 24 hours in advance of 6 (d) 7 terminating a transient occupancy, and shall release to the guest all personal property of the guest 8 within 24 hours after termination of a transient occupancy. An innkeeper shall maintain a written record of the length of occupancy of each 9 (e) transient occupancy and shall provide a guest with written notice when the occupancy has 10 11 reached 45 consecutive days. 12

<u>(f)</u> <u>An innkeeper shall not require a guest to move to a different room or to check out and</u>
<u>check back in for the purpose of commencing a new period of transient occupancy.</u>"".
