Short Title: Four-Year Term for Mayor/Siler City. (Local)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE MAYOR FOR THE TOWN OF SILER CITY
3 FROM TWO YEARS TO A FOUR-YEAR TERM.
4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5 SECTION 1. Section 4 of the Charter of the Town of Siler City, being Chapter 88
6 of the Private Laws of 1887, as amended by Section 1 of Chapter 860 of the 1963 Session Laws,
7 reads as rewritten:
8 "Sec. 4. The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Town of Siler City shall be elected
9 on Tuesday after the first Monday in May in the odd-numbered years in accordance with the
10 following:
11 (a) At the regular municipal election to be held in May, 1965, the two candidates for
12 Commissioner receiving the highest number of votes shall be elected to serve for a term of four
13 (4) years and the other three candidates elected as Commissioner shall serve for a term of two
14 (2) years. Thereafter, Commissioners shall be elected to serve for four-year terms.
15 (b) ~~On Tuesday after the first Monday in May, 1965, and biennially thereafter, Beginning~~
16 at the regular municipal election in 2023 and quadrennially thereafter, the Mayor shall be elected
17 for a two-year-four-year term."
18 SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to elections held
19 on or after that date.
