1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO REDUCE THE TIME A LIMITED LEARNER'S PERMIT MUST BE HELD
3 BEFORE OBTAINING A LIMITED PROVISIONAL LICENSE AND TO AMEND THE
4 PASSENGER RESTRICTIONS APPLICABLE TO LIMITED PROVISIONAL LICENSE
5 HOLDERS.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.(a)** Section 2 of S.L. 2021-24, as amended by Section 12 of S.L.
8 2021-134, reads as rewritten:

9 "**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to applications for
10 licenses submitted on or after that date. Section 1 of this act expires on ~~December 31,~~
11 2022-December 31, 2023."

12 **SECTION 1.(b)** This section is effective when it becomes law.

13 **SECTION 2.(a)** G.S. 20-11 reads as rewritten:

14 "**§ 20-11. Issuance of limited learner's permit and provisional drivers license to person who**
15 **is less than 18 years old.**

16 ...

17 (d) Level 2. – A person who is at least 16 years old but less than 18 years old may obtain
18 a limited provisional license if the person meets all of the following requirements:

19 (1) Has held a limited learner's permit issued by the Division for at least ~~12~~nine
20 months.

21"

22 **SECTION 2.(b)** This section becomes effective January 1, 2024, and applies to
23 applications for licenses submitted on or after that date.

24 **SECTION 3.(a)** G.S. 20-11(e)(4) reads as rewritten:

25 "(4) When the license holder is driving the vehicle and is not accompanied by the
26 supervising driver, there may be no more than one passenger under 21 years
27 of age in the vehicle. This limit does not apply to passengers who are members
28 of the license holder's immediate family or whose primary residence is the
29 same household as the license holder. However, if a family member or
30 member of the same household as the license holder who is younger than 21
31 years of age is a passenger in the vehicle, no other passengers under 21 years
32 of age, who are not members of the license holder's immediate family or
33 members of the license holder's household, may be in the ~~vehicle.~~vehicle,
34 except that one other passenger under 21 years of age who is not a member of
35 the license holder's immediate family or member of the license holder's

1 household may be in the vehicle when that passenger is a student being driven
2 directly to or from school."

3 **SECTION 3.(b)** This section becomes effective August 1, 2023, and applies to
4 offenses committed on or after that date.

5 **SECTION 4.** Except as otherwise provided, this act is effective when it becomes
6 law.
