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HOUSE BILL 187 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE H187-PCS40206-BE-9

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Short Title: Equality in Education. (Public) Sponsors: Referred to: February 27, 2023 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO DEMONSTRATE THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY'S INTENT THAT STUDENTS, TEACHERS, ADMINISTRATORS, AND OTHER SCHOOL EMPLOYEES RECOGNIZE THE EQUALITY AND RIGHTS OF ALL PERSONS AND TO PROHIBIT PUBLIC SCHOOL UNITS FROM PROMOTING CERTAIN CONCEPTS THAT ARE CONTRARY TO THAT INTENT. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 8 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 115C-81.61. Ensuring dignity and nondiscrimination in schools. The General Assembly finds that Section 1 of Article I of the Constitution of this State recognizes the equality and rights of all persons. Therefore, it is the intent of the General Assembly that students, teachers, administrators, and other school employees respect the dignity of others, acknowledge the right of others to express differing opinions, and foster and defend intellectual honesty, freedom of inquiry and instruction, and freedom of speech and association and that the public schools of North Carolina employ teaching methods and procedures to further that intent. For the purposes of this section, "promote" shall mean compelling students, teachers, (b) administrators, or other school employees to affirm or profess belief in the concepts described in subsection (c) of this section. Public school units shall not promote that: (c) One race or sex is inherently superior to another race or sex. (1) An individual, solely by virtue of his or her race or sex, is inherently racist, (2) sexist, or oppressive. An individual should be discriminated against or receive adverse treatment (3) solely or partly because of his or her race or sex. (4) An individual's moral character is necessarily determined by his or her race or An individual, solely by virtue of his or her race or sex, bears responsibility (5) for actions committed in the past by other members of the same race or sex. Any individual, solely by virtue of his or her race or sex, should feel (6) discomfort, guilt, anguish, or any other form of psychological distress. A meritocracy is inherently racist or sexist. <u>(7)</u> The United States was created by members of a particular race or sex for the (8) purpose of oppressing members of another race or sex.



The United States government should be violently overthrown.

SECTION 2. G.S. 115C-218.85(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: A charter school shall comply with G.S. 115C-81.61 in order to ensure dignity "(6) and nondiscrimination at the charter school."
