The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
<b>SECTION 1.</b> There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of		
Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of five million dollars		
(\$5,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2023-2024 fiscal year to be used to award grants on a		
competitive basis to nonprofit community health centers. Nonprofit community health centers		
selected to receive these grant funds shall use all such funds to purchase and make available		
long-acting reversible contraceptives for underserved, uninsured, or medically indigent patients.		
As used in this section, the term "long-acting reversible contraceptives" means a contraceptive		
drug or device that meets all of the following criteria:		
(1	) Is a method of birth control that provides effective contraception f	or an
	extended period of time without depending upon user action.	
(2		ect to
	discontinue.	
(3	Has been approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration	on for
	use as a contraceptive.	
(4	Is obtained under a prescription written by a health care provider authorized as the second of the s	orized
	to prescribe medications under the laws of this State.	

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2023.
