7	(d) Any newspaper that publishes public notices shall provide notice that public notices
8	may be published on the county-maintained website, in the newspaper, or both.
9	(e) Nothing in this section requires a county to adopt an ordinance authorizing the county
10	to publish notices on a county-maintained website."
11	SECTION 2.(b) This section applies only to Onslow County.
12	SECTION 2.(c) This section is effective when it becomes law and applies to notices
13	published on or after that date.
14	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
