Senator Marcus

1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 15-16, by rewriting the lines to read:

3 "subsection (a) of this section shall require that searches of a student's person are conducted in

private by one school official and one adult witness, both of whom shall be the same sex as the 4

5 student. The policy may provide an exception to this requirement for searches conducted using a

walk-through metal detector, handheld wand, or other similar minimally intrusive device 6

7 designed to detect weapons and regularly used for security scanning.

8 In non-exigent circumstances, a student's parents must receive notification from (c) school officials of the intent to search a student in accordance with subsection (a) of this section 9 and must be given the opportunity to be present during the search. In exigent circumstances, a 10 11 student's parents must be notified within 24 hours of any search performed in accordance with subsection (a) of this section. 12

13 On a quarterly basis, all local education agencies shall submit a report to the (d) Department of Public Instruction detailing the number of searches conducted in accordance with 14 subsection (a) of this section, the reason for the search, and the age, gender, and race of all 15 students searched."".
