- 1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 15-16, by rewriting the lines to read:

- 3 "subsection (a) of this section shall require that searches of a student's person are conducted in
- 4 private by one school official and one adult witness, both of whom shall be the same sex as the
- 5 student. The policy may provide an exception to this requirement for searches conducted using a
- 6 walk-through metal detector, handheld wand, or other similar minimally intrusive device
- 7 designed to detect weapons and regularly used for security scanning.
- 8 (c) In non-exigent circumstances, a student's parents must receive notification from
- 9 school officials of the intent to search a student in accordance with subsection (a) of this section
- 10 and must be given the opportunity to be present during the search. In exigent circumstances, a
- 11 student's parents must be notified within 24 hours of any search performed in accordance with
- 12 subsection (a) of this section.
- 13 (d) On a quarterly basis, all local education agencies shall submit a report to the
- 14 Department of Public Instruction detailing the number of searches conducted in accordance with
- 15 subsection (a) of this section, the reason for the search, and the age, gender, and race of all
- 16 students searched."
