SENATE BILL DRS45248-NE-18A

Short Title: The Patrick Mays Hazard Light Safety Act. (Public)

Sponsors: Senators Marcus, Sawyer, and Hunt (Primary Sponsors).

Referred to:

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT REQUIRING THE USE OF HAZARD WARNING SIGNAL LAMPS FOR  
3 VEHICLES STOPPED IN HIGHWAY TRAFFIC.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. G.S. 20-134 reads as rewritten:

6 "§ 20-134. Lights on parked and stopped vehicles.

7 ...

8 (a1) Whenever a vehicle is stopped upon a highway with a posted speed limit of 45 miles  
9 per hour or greater, the vehicle shall be operated with its hazard warning signal lamps  
10 illuminated, if so equipped. Violation of this section does not constitute negligence per se in any  
11 civil action. Nothing in this subsection shall be interpreted to abrogate the provisions of  
12 G.S. 20-161. For purposes of this subsection, "hazard warning signal lamps" means special lights  
13 on a vehicle that flash on and off and are primarily used to warn other drivers that a vehicle is  
14 slowing down, reversing, or stationary.

15 ...."

16 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2023.
