Short Title: (Public) Clarify Felony/Voting Without Rights Restored. Sponsors: Representative Everitt. Referred to: 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE A KNOWING VIOLATION OF THE LAW TO DECLARE IT A 3 FELONY WHEN A PERSON CONVICTED OF A CRIME VOTES IN AN ELECTION 4 WITHOUT HAVING BEEN RESTORED THE RIGHTS OF CITIZENSHIP. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 163-275(5) reads as rewritten: For any person convicted of a crime which excludes the person from the right 7 of suffrage, to knowingly vote at any primary or election without having been 8 restored to the right of citizenship in due course and by the method provided 9 10 by law." 11 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to violations 12 occurring on or after that date.
