A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT REGARDING THE FILLING OF VACANCIES ON THE BOARD OF
COMMISSIONERS OF CABARRUS COUNTY.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 153A-27(a) reads as rewritten:

6 "(a) If a vacancy occurs on the board of commissioners, the remaining members of the 7 board shall appoint a qualified person to fill the vacancy. If the number of vacancies on the board 8 is such that a quorum of the board cannot be obtained, the chairman of the board shall appoint 9 enough members to make up a quorum, and the board shall then proceed to fill the remaining 10 vacancies. If the number of vacancies on the board is such that a quorum of the board cannot be obtained and the office of chairman is vacant, the clerk of superior court of the county shall fill 11 the vacancies upon the request of any remaining member of the board or upon the petition of any 12 five registered voters of the county. If for any other reason the remaining members of the board 13 14 do not fill a vacancy within 60-20 calendar days after the day the vacancy occurs, the clerk shall immediately report the vacancy to the clerk of superior court of the county. The clerk of superior 15 court shall, within 10 calendar days after the day the vacancy is reported to him, fill the vacancy." 16 **SECTION 2.** This act applies only to Cabarrus County. 17 18 SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to vacancies

19 existing on or after that date.
