A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT EXTENDING THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE SOUTHEAST 3 REGIONAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY FROM TWO TO FOUR YEARS AND 4 AUTHORIZING THE SOUTHEAST REGIONAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY TO CONVEY 5 REAL OR PERSONAL PROPERTY BELONGING TO THE AUTHORITY BY PRIVATE 6 NEGOTIATION AND SALE OR LONG-TERM LEASE. 7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 8 **SECTION 1.(a)** Section 2(b) of S.L. 2020-19 reads as rewritten: 9 "SECTION 2.(b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, members Members shall serve for a term of two-four years, beginning on January 1, and the terms shall be staggered. 10 Members may serve no more than two successive terms. An initial term described in subsection 11 12 (c) of this section shall be counted when determining the number of successive terms served. A 13 member who has served two successive terms may not be reappointed to the Authority except 14 after a lapse of two years following the most recent term served. In the event a member is 15 appointed to fill an unexpired term, and at least one year two years of the unexpired term remains to be served, the appointment shall be counted in determining the number of successive terms 16 17 served. Upon the expiration of a member's term, the member may continue to serve until a 18 successor has been appointed, but in no case shall the member serve for more than 60 days 19 beyond the end of the member's term. Any vacancy occurring among the membership of the

Authority shall be filled within 60 days after notice thereof by the appointment of a successor by the mayor or chair who made the original appointment. The successor member shall serve for the remainder of the unexpired term. Each member shall take and subscribe before the clerk of the town or county an oath of office, and the oath shall be filed in the office of the clerk. The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to the Scotland County Economic Development Director who shall not be limited to the number of terms he or she may serve."

**SECTION 1.(b)** Section 2(c) of S.L. 2020-19 is repealed.

SECTION 1.(c) The terms of the current members of the Southeast Regional Airport
Authority shall expire on December 31, 2023. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2(b) of
S.L. 2020-19, as amended by subsection (a) of this section, the current members of the Authority
may be reappointed to the Authority as provided in subsection (d) and subsection (e) of this
section.

32 **SECTION 1.(d)** For the appointments beginning January 1, 2024, the members of 33 the Authority shall be as follows:

Three registered voters of the City of Laurinburg appointed by the Mayor of
the City, one of whom shall serve for a term of one year, one of whom shall

		of S.L. 2020-19, as amended by subsection (a) of this section.

	"SECTION	<b>4.</b> Powers; Duties. – The Authority shall have the following powers and duties:	
	(3)	To sell, lease, or otherwise dispose of any property, real or personal, belonging	
		to the Authority, according to the procedures provided in Article 12 of Chapter	
		160A of the General Statutes, Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 12 of	
		Chapter 160A of the General Statutes, to convey by private negotiation and	
		sale, or to lease for a term of more than 10 years without it being treated as a	
		sale, under the terms and conditions it deems proper, any or all of its right,	
		title, and interest in Authority real or personal property, but no sale of real	
		property shall be made without the approval of the City of Laurinburg City	
		Council, Town of Maxton Town Council, and Scotland County Board of	
		Commissioners.
