11	(a) Except	ot as provided in this section, the governing board may adopt an ordinance	
12	providing that an	y notice it is required by law to publish or advertise, whether under G.S. 1-597,	
13	under Article 8 o	f Chapter 143 of the General Statutes, under any other general law, or under any	
14	local act, may be	published electronically as provided by this section in lieu of or in addition to	
15	the required pub	lication or advertisement. The ordinance may cover all notices required to be	
16	published or adv	ertised or a clearly identified category of notices.	
17	<u>(b)</u> <u>Upon</u>	adoption of an ordinance under subsection (a) of this section, the governing	
18	board shall publish specific instructions as to how to access all notices published electronically

28		website for at least one year after publication and shall be searchable.	
29	<u>(4)</u>	A copy of the notice shall be filed in a notice book maintained separate and

31		book shall be appropriately indexed and maintained for public inspection in	
32		the office of the clerk or in the office of another individual who is an employee
