A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF HENDERSONVILLE TO USE PROCEEDS FROM 3 ON-STREET PARKING METERS TO FUND CAPITAL PROJECTS, AND TO PROVIDE 4 FOR EVEN-YEAR ELECTIONS AND TO EXTEND THE TERMS OF ELECTED 5 OFFICERS IN THE TOWNS OF HARMONY AND LOVE VALLEY. 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 7 8 PART I. HENDERSONVILLE ON-STREET PARKING PROCEEDS 9 **SECTION 1.(a)** In addition to the uses authorized under G.S. 160A-301(a), a 10 municipality may use the proceeds from parking meters on public streets to fund any capital 11 projects. 12 **SECTION 1.(b)** This Part applies to the City of Hendersonville only. 13 14 PART II. TOWN OF HARMONY ELECTION CHANGES 15 **SECTION 2.(a)** Notwithstanding the order of the Municipal Control Board, dated February 10, 1927, regular municipal elections in the Town of Harmony shall be held at the time 16 of the general election in each even-numbered year. Election of the mayor and town council 17 18 members shall be on a nonpartisan plurality basis and the results determined in accordance with G.S. 163-292. Except as otherwise provided by this act, the election shall be conducted in 19 20 accordance with the uniform municipal election laws in Chapter 163 of the General Statutes. The mayor shall serve a four-year term, and town council members shall serve staggered four-year 21 22 terms. 23 **SECTION 2.(b)** Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section, the mayor and town 24 council members elected in the 2023 regular municipal elections shall serve for a one-year term. 25 SECTION 2.(c) In 2024, a mayor and four town council members shall be elected. In the 2024 election, to implement staggering of terms for town council members, the two 26 27 candidates receiving the highest number of votes shall serve four-year terms, and the two candidates receiving the next highest number of votes shall serve two-year terms. In 2026 and 28 29 quadrennially thereafter, two town council members shall be elected to serve four-year terms. In 30 2028 and quadrennially thereafter, a mayor and two town council members shall be elected to 31 serve four-year terms. 32 SECTION 2.(d) This Part is effective when it becomes law and applies to elections 33 held on or after that date. 34

35 PART III. TOWN OF LOVE VALLEY ELECTION CHANGES

SECTION 3.(a) Notwithstanding the order of the Municipal Control Board, dated 1 2 March 29, 1963, regular municipal elections in the Town of Love Valley shall be held at the time 3 of the general election in each even-numbered year. Election of the mayor and commissioners 4 shall be on a nonpartisan plurality basis and the results determined in accordance with 5 G.S. 163-292. Except as otherwise provided by this act, the election shall be conducted in 6 accordance with the uniform municipal election laws in Chapter 163 of the General Statutes. The 7 mayor shall serve a four-year term, and commissioners shall serve staggered four-year terms. 8 **SECTION 3.(b)** Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section, the mayor and five 9 commissioners elected in the 2023 regular municipal elections shall serve for a one-year term. 10 SECTION 3.(c) In 2024, a mayor and five commissioners shall be elected. In the 11 2024 election, to implement staggering of terms for commissioners, the two candidates receiving 12 the highest number of votes shall serve four-year terms, and the three candidates receiving the 13 next highest number of votes shall serve two-year terms. In 2026 and quadrennially thereafter, 14 three commissioners shall be elected to serve four-year terms. In 2028 and quadrennially thereafter, a mayor and two commissioners shall be elected to serve four-year terms. 15 **SECTION 3.(d)** This Part is effective when it becomes law and applies to elections 16 17 held on or after that date. 18 19 PART IV. EFFECTIVE DATE 20 SECTION 4. Except as otherwise provided, this act is effective when it becomes
