11 **"PART I-A. REQUIREMENTS FOR APPOINTMENTS MADE BY THE GENERAL
12 ASSEMBLY**

13 **SECTION 1A.1. G.S. 120-121 reads as rewritten:**

14 **"§ 120-121. Legislative appointments.**

15 ...

16 (g) Members appointed by the General Assembly upon the recommendation of the
17 Speaker of the House of Representatives shall, to the degree practicable, be proportional to the
18 party representation in the House of Representatives. Members appointed by the General
19 Assembly upon the recommendation of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall, to the
20 degree practicable, be proportional to the party representation in the Senate.

21 (h) The General Assembly shall not appoint any of the following individuals:

- 22 (1) A member of the General Assembly serving currently or in the five years prior
23 to appointment, or that member's spouse.
- 24 (2) A member of the Council of State, serving currently or in the five years prior
25 to appointment, or that member's spouse. This restriction shall not bar a
26 member of the Council of State from serving in an ex officio capacity.
- 27 (3) A lobbyist registered with the Secretary of State currently or in the five years
28 prior to appointment, or that lobbyist's spouse.
- 29 (4) An individual who made a campaign donation to the campaign committee of
30 any individual running for statewide office or for the General Assembly in the
31 two years prior to the appointment.
