



## NORTH CAROLINA GENERAL ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT Senate Bill 749

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#### Representative Morey

moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 27, through page 3, line 16, by rewriting those lines to read:

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#### "SECTION 2.1. G.S. 163-19 reads as rewritten:

### "§ 163-19. State Board of Elections; appointment; term of office; vacancies; oath of office.

- (a) There is established the State Board of Elections, which may be referred to as the "State Board" in this Chapter.
- (b) The State Board of Elections shall consist of five seven registered voters whose terms of office shall begin on May 1, 2019, May 1 of the year following the election for Council of State members and shall continue for four years, and until their successors are appointed and qualified. The Governor shall appoint the members of the State Board and likewise shall appoint their successors every four years at the expiration of each four year term. No person may serve more than two consecutive four-year terms.
- (b1) Not more than three members of the State Board shall be members of the same political party. Of the membership, Thethe Governor shall appoint five of the members from a list of nominees submitted to the Governor by the State party chair of each of the two political parties having the highest number of registered affiliates as reflected by the latest registration statistics published by the State Board. Each party chair shall submit a list of four nominees who are affiliated with that political party. No person may serve more than two consecutive four year terms.

4	(c) Any vacancy of a member appointed under subsection (b1) of this section occurring				
5	in the Sta	in the State Board shall be filled by the Governor, and the person so appointed shall fill the			
6	unexpired	unexpired term. The Governor shall fill the vacancy from a list of three nominees submitted to			
7	the Governor by the State party chair of the political party that nominated the vacating member				
8	as provided in subsection (b) subsection (b1) of this section. The three nominees must be				
9	affiliated with that political party. Any vacancy of a member appointed under subsection (b2) of				
10	this section shall be filled by the appointing authority for the unexpired term.				
11	(d) At the first meeting held after new appointments are made, the members of the State				
12	Board shall take the following oath:				
13	"I,, do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will support the Constitution of the United				
14	States; that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to the State of North Carolina, and to the				
15	constitutional powers and authorities which are or may be established for the government thereof;				
16	that I will endeavor to support, maintain, and defend the Constitution of said State, and that I will				
17	well and truly execute the duties of the office of member of the State Board of Elections according				
18	to the bes	•	y knowledge and ability, according to law, so help me God."		
19	(e)		r taking the prescribed oath, the State Board shall organize by electing one of its		
20	members chair and another secretary.				
21	(f)	No p	erson shall be eligible to serve as a member of the State Board who:		
22		(1)	Holds any elective or appointive office under the government of the United		
23			States, the State of North Carolina, or any political subdivision thereof.		
24		(2)	Is a candidate for nomination or election to any office.		
25		(3)	Holds any office in a political party or organization.		
26		(4)	Is a campaign manager or treasurer of any candidate in a primary or election.		
27		(5)	Is currently an employee of the State, a community college, or a local school		
28			administrative unit.		
29			Within the 48 months prior to appointment, has held any of the following		
30			positions with an organization that has engaged in electioneering in those 48		
31			months:		
32			a. Director, officer, or governing board member.		
33			b. Employee.		
34			c. Lobbyist registered under Chapter 120C of the General Statutes.		
35			d. Independent contractor.		
36			e. Legal counsel of record.

38		(1)	Make a reportable contribution to a candidate for a public office over which		
39			the State Board would have jurisdiction or authority.		
40		(2)	Register as a lobbyist under Chapter 120C of the General Statutes.

election of one or more clearly identified candidates for public office.
