moves to amend the bill on page 7, lines 25-36, by rewriting those lines to read:

"SECTION 7.(b) No municipal elections shall be conducted in the Town of Hookerton in 2025. The terms of office for each commissioner and mayor serving on January 1, 2025, shall be extended by one year. Regular municipal elections shall be conducted in the Town of Hookerton in even-numbered years beginning in 2026 as terms expire.

**SECTION 7.(c)** In 2026 and biennially thereafter, a mayor shall be elected to serve a two-year term. In 2026 and quadrennially thereafter, two commissioners shall be elected to serve four-year terms. In 2028 and quadrennially thereafter, two commissioners shall be elected to serve four-year terms.

**SECTION 7.(d)** This section is effective January 1, 2025, and applies to elections held on or after that date.";

and on page 7, line 49, through page 8, line 6, by rewriting those lines to read:

"SECTION 8.(b) No municipal elections shall be conducted in the Town of Walstonburg in 2025. The terms of office for the five commissioners and mayor elected in 2023 whose terms are set to expire in 2025 shall be extended by one year. Regular municipal elections shall be conducted in the Town of Walstonburg in even-numbered years beginning in 2026.

**SECTION 8.(c)** In 2026 and biennially thereafter, a mayor and five commissioners shall be elected to serve a two-year term.

**SECTION 8.(d)** This section is effective January 1, 2025, and applies to elections held on or after that date.".
