The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.(a)** Part 1 of Article 8 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 115C-81.22. Gambling addiction education. Instruction shall be provided in middle school and high school health education courses on the addictive potential of gambling and the costs and consequences of a gambling addiction." **SECTION 1.(b)** G.S. 115C-218.85(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: The school shall provide instruction on the addictive potential of gambling "(8) and the costs and consequences of a gambling addiction." **SECTION 1.(c)** G.S. 115C-238.66(1) is amended by adding a new sub-subdivision to read: "h. The board of directors shall ensure that instruction is provided on the addictive potential of gambling and the costs and consequences of a gambling addiction." **SECTION 1.(d)** G.S. 115C-150.12C is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: "(3b) Gambling addiction education. – The board of trustees shall ensure that instruction is provided on the addictive potential of gambling and the costs
