 4 AVAILABILITY OF EXPUNGED RECORDS.";

 7 By rewriting those lines to read:
 8 " **PART II. EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY AUTOMATIC EXPUNCTION PAUSE**
 9 **SECTION 2.(a)** Subsection (b) of Section 1 of S.L. 2022-47, as amended by Section
 10 14.5 of S.L. 2023-103, reads as rewritten:
 11 "SECTION 1.(b) This section becomes effective August 1, 2022, and expires ~~July 1,~~
 12 ~~2024.~~December 1, 2024."
 13 **SECTION 2.(b)** Subsection (c) of Section 2 of S.L. 2022-47 reads as rewritten:
 14 **SECTION 2.(c)** When Section 1 of this act expires or is repealed, whichever occurs first,
 15 the Administrative Office of the Courts shall, within 180 days, expunge all dismissed charges,
 16 not guilty verdicts, and findings of not responsible that occurred during the period of time that
 17 Section 1 of this act was in effect and are eligible for automatic expunction pursuant to
 18 G.S. 15A-146(a4). Any expungement performed in accordance with this subsection shall be
 19 deemed to have occurred five business days after the date that the individual expunction was
 20 carried out by the Administrative Office of the Courts."
