12		SECTION 1.(c) This section is effective October 1, 2024, and applies to insurance
13	contracts	sued, renewed, or amended on or after that date.
14		SECTION 2. Effective July 1, 2024, there is appropriated from the General Fund to
15	the Depar	nent of State Treasurer the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) in recurring funds
16	for the 20	4-2025 fiscal year to ensure compliance with Section 1(b) of this act by the North
17	Carolina S	ate Health Plan for Teachers and State Employees.
18		SECTION 3. Except as otherwise provided, this act is effective when it becomes
