7	<u>(a)</u> Loc	al educational agencies furnishing special education and related se	ervices to	
8	children with	disabilities may contract with private special education facilities of	or service	
9	providers to furnish any of these services that the public providers are unable to furnish.services.			
10	(b) As used in this subsection, "nursing services" are services that may only be provided			
11	by nurses licensed in accordance with Article 9A of Chapter 90 of the General Statutes. When			
12	providing nursing services pursuant to a child's IEP, local educational agencies shall make			
13	available the parent's choice of nurse if all of the following apply:			
14	<u>(1)</u>	The child's IEP requires nursing services.		
15	<u>(2)</u>	The child received nursing services from the nurse (i) prior to the		
16		services being required by the child's IEP or (ii) prior to the child en	nrolling in	
17		his or her current school.		
18	<u>(3)</u>	The parent's choice of nurse is employed by a nursing agency and	willing to	
19		provide the nursing services required by the child's IEP.		
20	<u>(4)</u>	The nursing agency employing the parent's choice of nurse meets al		
21		contract terms required for any other nursing agency contracted by	the local	
22		educational agency, including licensing and liability requirements.		
23	<u>(5)</u>	The contracted rate is equal to or less than the contracted rate of oth	her nurses	
24		contracted by the local educational agency.		
25		s section shall not be construed to limit the local educational	agency's	
26	responsibility to provide a free appropriate public education."			
27	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with			
28	the 2025-2026 school year.			



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
