5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 14-49 reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 14-49. Malicious use of explosive or incendiary; punishment.
8	(a) <u>Any person who possesses any explosive or incendiary device or material when the</u>
9	circumstances indicate some probability that such device or material will be so used to violate
10	this section is guilty of a Class H felony.
11	(a1) Any person who willfully and maliciously injures another by the use of any explosive
12	or incendiary device or material is guilty of a Class D felony.
13	
14	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2025, and applies to offenses
15	committed on or after that date.
