6	SECT	FION 1. Findings and Purpose. – The General Assembly finds that decades of				
7	barriers to entry, rising land prices, and economic consolidation have led to the loss of millions					
8	of acres of land	farmed by small farmers. The General Assembly further finds that financial				
9	assistance throug	targeted grants can help address disparities and contribute to the long-term				
10		farmers. The purpose of this act is to support the viability and sustainability of				
11		North Carolina by providing financial assistance to support these farmers.
