1 2 3 4	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE EDUCATION RECORDS OF MINOR COMMUNITY COLLEGE STUDENTS TO THE PARENTS OF THE DEPENDENT STUDENT. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Leon's Law."
6 7	SECTION 2. Chapter 115D of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:
8	" <u>§ 115D-10.80. Education records of minor students.</u>
9	(a) The State Board of Community Colleges shall direct each community college to adopt
10	a policy that does all of the following:
11	(1) To the extent allowed under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act
12	(FERPA), 20 U.S.C. § 1232g, provides education records, as defined in 34
13	C.F.R. § 99.3, of minor students to that student's parent if all of the following
14	criteria are met:
15	<u>a.</u> The student is below the age of 18.
16	b. The student is a dependent, as defined in section 152 of the Internal
17	Revenue Code of 1986, of the parent.
18	c. <u>The parent has not opted out of receiving the records.</u>
19	(2) Requires minor students whose education records are subject to subdivision
20	(1) of this subsection to complete a form, prior to registration in any course at
21	the community college, acknowledging that the parents of the student have
22	access to the education records of the student.
23	(b) For the purposes of this section, "parent" is defined as the parent, guardian, or an
24	individual acting as a parent in the absence of a parent or guardian of a student."
25 26	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with the 2025 2026 academic year
