- 1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 5, by inserting the following at the end of the line before
- 2 the period:
- 3 "AND TO ESTABLISH A SCHOLARSHIP FOR CHILDREN OF PERMANENTLY
- 4 DISABLED OR SLAIN NC LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS";
- 5
- 6 And on page 7, lines 47-48, by inserting the following between those lines:
- 7 "SECTION 16.7. The University of North Carolina Board of Governors shall
- 8 develop a scholarship program for any child, if the child is at least 17 years old but not yet 28
- 9 years old, whose parent, legal guardian, or legal custodian is a law enforcement officer,
- 10 correctional officer, firefighter, volunteer firefighter, or rescue squad worker who is permanently
- 11 and totally disabled as a direct result of a traumatic injury sustained in the line of duty.
- 12 The scholarship program shall provide assistance with tuition, fees, educational supplies, and
- 13 boarding expenses not covered under Chapter 115B of the General Statutes and shall be available
- 14 for both undergraduate and graduate programs.
- 15 The Board of Governors shall report to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee
- 16 on the establishment of the program no later than July 1, 2026."
