SENATE BILL DRS15214-NLa-33

Short Title: Medicaid SUD Services Rate Adjustment Act. (Public)

Sponsors: Senators Meyer, Adcock, and Batch (Primary Sponsors).

Referred to:

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH AND ADJUST MEDICAID REIMBURSEMENT RATES FOR  
3 SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER SERVICES.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** The Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Health  
6 Benefits, shall make all of the following adjustments to the Medicaid Program:

- 7 (1) Increase rates paid for ASAM level 2.1 substance use intensive outpatient  
8 program services to two hundred fifty-five dollars and twenty-eight cents  
9 (\$255.28) per diem.  
10 (2) Increase the rates paid for ASAM level 2.5 substance use comprehensive  
11 outpatient treatment program services to four hundred dollars (\$400.00) per  
12 diem.  
13 (3) Establish coverage for ASAM level 3.1 clinically managed low-intensity  
14 Residential Treatment services. A rate of three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00)  
15 per diem shall be paid for these services.  
16 (4) Establish coverage for ASAM level 3.3 clinically managed high-intensity  
17 treatment services. A rate of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) per diem shall  
18 be paid for these services.  
19 (5) Establish coverage for ASAM level 3.5 clinically managed residential  
20 treatment services. A rate of five hundred fifty dollars (\$550.00) per diem  
21 shall be paid for these services.  
22 (6) Increase the rates paid for ASAM level 3.7 substance use medically monitored  
23 community residential treatment services to six hundred fifty dollars  
24 (\$650.00) per diem.  
25 (7) Increase the rates paid for ASAM level 3.7 non-hospital medical  
26 detoxification services to seven hundred fifty-six dollars and sixty-five cents  
27 (\$756.65) per diem.

28 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
29 Health and Human Services, Division of Health Benefits, the sum of fifteen million dollars  
30 (\$15,000,000) in recurring funds for each year of the 2025-2027 fiscal biennium to be used to  
31 effectuate the rate changes under this act. These funds shall provide a State match for  
32 twenty-seven million four hundred thousand dollars (\$27,400,000) in recurring federal funds for  
33 each year of the 2025-2027 fiscal biennium, and those funds are appropriated to the Division of  
34 Health Benefits for the same purpose.

35 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2025.
