4	SECTION 3.(b) Article 12 of Chapter 153A of the General Statutes is amended by
5	adding a new section to read:
6	" <u>§ 153A-245.1. Regulation of electric bicycles.</u>
7	A county may regulate the use of an electric assisted bicycle in accordance with
8	G.S. 160A-300.2. Nothing in this section shall be deemed to restrict or repeal the authority of a
9	city to regulate the use of an electric assisted bicycle."
10	SECTION 4. The Department of Transportation shall develop educational materials
11	on the proper use and safety considerations of electric assisted bicycles.
12	SECTION 5. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to all electric
13	assisted bicycle riders and passengers on or after that date.
