SECTION 1. G.S. 20-114.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(e) A person holding a motorcycle road guard certificate issued under G.S. 20-114.2 may direct traffic while escorting a motorcycle group if the person meets the safety and equipment standards for operating under the certificate; has notified each city through which the motorcycle group is proceeding; and has obtained consent from the chief of police of that city."

SECTION 2. Article 3 of Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 20-114.2. Motorcycle road guard certificate.

- (a) No person may direct traffic as a motorcycle road guard under G.S. 20-114.1(e) without a valid motorcycle road guard certificate issued in accordance with this section.
- (b) A person who is at least 18 years of age and has a valid drivers license may obtain a motorcycle road guard certificate upon successful completion of a motorcycle road guard certification course developed by the Division and by meeting any other requirements of the Division.
- (c) In the course of directing traffic, a motorcycle road guard shall comply with all safety and equipment standards required by the Division."
- **SECTION 3.** The Division of Motor Vehicles shall adopt rules to carry out the provisions of this act.
- **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2025.
