5	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-7(f) reads as rewritten:
6	"(f) Duration and Renewal of Licenses. – Drivers licenses shall be issued and renewed
7	pursuant to the provisions of this subsection:
8	
9	(6) Remote renewal or conversion. – Subject to the following requirements and
10	limitations, the Division may offer remote renewal of a drivers license or
11	remote conversion of a full provisional license issued by the Division:
12	a. Requirements. – To be eligible for remote renewal or conversion under
13	this subdivision, a person must meet all of the following requirements:
14	
15	4. For a remote renewal, <u>renewal:</u>
16	I. Of a license that complies with regulations adopted
17	pursuant to the REAL ID Act of 2005, 49 U.S.C. §
18	30301, the most recent renewal was an in-person
19 20	renewal and not a remote renewal under this
20	subdivision.
21 22	II. Of a drivers license that is not REAL ID compliant, a
22	person may remotely renew a license on two
23 24	consecutive occasions. After two consecutive remote renewals, a non-REAL ID compliant license shall be
24 25	renewed in person.

20 27	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 2026, and applies to licenses
28	renewed on or after that date.
