Sponsors: Referred to: March 10, 2025 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO ENCOURAGE NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF 3 TOBACCO PRODUCTS AND HEMP-DERIVED CONSUMABLE PRODUCTS ON 4 SCHOOL GROUNDS. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-551(b) reads as rewritten: 7 All private church schools and all schools of religious charter are encouraged to do "(b)8 the following: 9 10 (5) Tobacco products and hemp-derived consumable products. – Adopt a policy to prohibit the use of tobacco products and hemp-derived consumable 11 products on school grounds, using the requirements of Article 29A of this 12 Chapter as guidance for the policy." 13 14 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 115C-559(b) reads as rewritten: 15 All qualified nonpublic schools are encouraged to do the following: "(b) 16 17 (5) Tobacco products and hemp-derived consumable products. – Adopt a policy 18 to prohibit the use of tobacco products and hemp-derived consumable products on school grounds, using the requirements of Article 29A of this 19 20 Chapter as guidance for the policy." **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law. 21
