19		(6)	Conducting or participating in an externally funded research project at one of		
20			the constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina.		
21		(7)	Researching issues related to the drafting or analysis of the laws of this State		
22			as necessary to fulfill the requirements of the employee's official duties.
