appeal. Upon motion of an aggrieved party, the court of the appellate division in which the appeal is pending may stay any order for civil contempt entered for child support until the appeal is decided, if justice requires.		
As a special condition of a contempt order, the court may direct the person into job search or dually specific education training. If the court selects this option, the court shall review the person's progress in 30-day intervals, at a minimum upless the person is appelled, and activally portionating in		
minimum, unless the person is enrolled and actively participating in work-specific training. The person's enrollment in work-specific training shall		
not exceed six months and the person shall satisfy all the following requirements:		
	a. Pay a minimum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) n b. Notify the court upon completion from wo c. Notify the court within 14 days of failir requirements of work-specific training.	ork-specific training.
