Short Title: Funds for Various Projects in Cabarrus Co. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR VARIOUS PROJECTS IN THE TOWNS OF MIDLAND AND HARRISBURG.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of State Budget and Management the sum of seven million dollars (\$7,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2025-2026 fiscal year to provide a directed grant to the Town of Midland for various road improvements in the Bethel Glen Development and the Tucker Chase Development.

**SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of State Budget and Management the sum of twelve million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$12,700,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2025-2026 fiscal year to provide a directed grant to the Town of Harrisburg to be used as follows:

- (1) Two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) for turf fields.
- (2) Nine million two hundred thousand dollars (\$9,200,000) for the Harrisburg passenger rail station.
- (3) One million dollars (\$1,000,000) to complete the Harrisburg YMCA building.

**SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of State Budget and Management the sum of one million nine hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,950,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2025-2026 fiscal year to provide a directed grant to Cabarrus County to be used for Cabarrus Rowan Community Health Center to expand and sustain access to care in the County.

**SECTION 4.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of State Budget and Management the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2025-2026 fiscal year to provide a directed grant to Cabarrus Cooperative Christian Ministry, Inc., a nonprofit organization, to assist members of the community experiencing crisis in the areas of food, housing, or finances.

**SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2025.
