29		Armed Forces of the United States. The plate shall bear (i) the words "U.S.	
30		Military Veteran" across the top of the plate and (ii) the name and insignia of	
31		the branch of service in which the individual served. served on the left side of	
32		the plate. The plate authorized by this subdivision is not subject to the	
33		provisions of G.S. 20-79.3A or G.S. 20-79.8.
