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
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"SECTION 6.6 G.S. 7A-354 reads as rewritten:

## "§ 7A-354. North Carolina Human Trafficking Commission.

- (a) Establishment. There is established in the Administrative Office of the Courts the
  North Carolina Human Trafficking Commission. For purposes of this section, "Commission"
  means the North Carolina Human Trafficking Commission.
- 16 (b) Membership. The Commission shall consist of no-more than-15 members as
  17 follows:
  - (1) The President Pro Tempore of the SenateGovernor shall appoint two representatives from the public at large and one representative from each of the following:
- 21 a. The public at large.
  - b.a. A county sheriff's office.
    - $e.\overline{b.}$  A city or town police department.
    - d.c. Legal Aid of North Carolina.
    - (2) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint one representative from each of the following:
      - a. The public at large.
        - b.d. North Carolina Coalition Against Human Trafficking.
- 29e.e.A faith-based shelter or benefits organization providing services to30victims of human trafficking.
  - d.<u>f.</u> A district attorney or an assistant district attorney.
- 32 (3) The Governor shall appoint one representative from each of the following:
