(5) (6) (7)	The person is not a fugitive from justice. The person is not an unlawful user of or addicted to any controlled substance. The person has not been adjudicated as mentally defective and has not been committed to any mental institution at 16 years of age or older.
(8) (9)	The person is not an alien, either illegally or unlawfully in the United States. The person has not been discharged from the Armed Forces under dishonorable conditions.
<u>(10)</u>	The person, having been a citizen of the United States, has not renounced his or her citizenship.
(11)	The person is not subject to a court order that restrains such person from harassing, stalking, or threatening an intimate partner of such person or child of such intimate partner or person, or engaging in other conduct that would place an intimate partner in reasonable fear of bodily injury to the partner or child.
<u>(12)</u>	The person has not been convicted in any court of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence.
