## 27 "§ 20-54. Authority for refusing registration or certificate of title.

- The Division shall refuse registration or issuance of a certificate of title or any transfer of registration upon any of the following grounds:
- 31(8)The vehicle is a golf cart or utility vehicle. For purposes of this subdivision,32the term "utility vehicle" shall not include a motorcycle designed for both33off-road and highway operation, provided that the motorcycle meets all of the34requirements for highway operation imposed by this Chapter.35...."
- **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2025.
