Annual report. 7 (a) Requirement. - Except as provided in G.S. 55-16-22.3 and in subsections (a1) and (a2) of this section, each domestic corporation and each foreign corporation authorized to transact 8 9 business in this State shall deliver an annual report directly to the Secretary of State in electronic 10 form or in paper form as prescribed by the Secretary of State under this section." **SECTION 1.(b)** Article 16 of Chapter 55 of the General Statutes is amended by 11 adding a new section to read: 12 13 "§ 55-16-22.3. 7	SECTION 5. The Secretary of State shall make available the form or forms needed
8	for the affidavit of deployment and affidavit of extended deployment required by this act and
9	shall take any other action necessary to allow business entities to begin filing pursuant to this act
10	on October 1, 2025.
11	SECTION 6. Sections 1 through 4 of this act become effective October 1, 2025. The
12	remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law.
