moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 9, by inserting before the period the words "AND TO PROHIBIT NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS FROM REQUIRING EMPLOYEES TO HAVE CONCEALED CARRY PERMITS";

and on page 2, lines 34-35, by inserting the following between the lines:

"SECTION 3.5. Article 39 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new Part to read:

"Part 6. Employee Requirements.

"§ 115C-568. Conditions of employment.

Notwithstanding G.S. 115C-554 and G.S. 115C-562, nonpublic schools subject to the requirements of Part 1 or Part 2 of this Article shall not require, as a condition of employment, any employee to have a concealed handgun permit issued in accordance with Article 54B of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes.

"§ 115C-568.5. Enforcement.

- (a) Any person may report a complaint of a violation of this Part to the Attorney General.
- (b) The Attorney General may investigate any complaints received alleging violation of this Part. If the Attorney General finds that there has been a violation of this Part, the Attorney General may bring an action to impose civil penalties and to seek any other appropriate relief, including equitable relief to restrain the violation. The penalty imposed for a violation of this Part shall be five thousand dollars (\$5000.00) for the first violation and fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for each repeat violation by a nonpublic school."".
