2025-2026 fiscal year and the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) in recurring funds for the		
2026-2027 fiscal year to be used to address the increased cost to the North Carolina State Health		
Plan for Teachers and State Employees as a result of the continuation of retiree medical members
