"SECTION 2.(a) G.S. 163-231(b) reads as rewritten:

 "(b) Transmitting Executed Absentee Ballots to County Board of Elections. Board. – The sealed container-return envelope in which executed absentee ballots have been placed shall be transmitted to the county board of elections—who issued those ballots as follows:

All ballots issued under the provisions of this Article and Article 21A of this Chapter shall be transmitted by one of the following means:

 a. Mail or commercial courier service, at the voter's expense, and received by the county board not later than 7:30 P.M. on the day of the statewide primary or general election or county bond election.

 b. Delivered in person, by the voter or the voter's near relative or verifiable legal guardian, to the county board not later than 7:30 P.M. on the day of the statewide primary or general election or county bond election

c. Electronically transmitted to the county board, if the ballot was issued under the provisions of Article 21A of this Chapter.

(2) If ballots are received later than the hour stated in subdivision (1) of this subsection, those ballots shall not be accepted unless one of the following applies:

<u>a.</u> <u>Acceptance of the ballots is required by federal law or the law.</u>

 b. The ballots issued under this Article are postmarked and that postmark is dated on or before the day of the statewide primary or general election or county bond election and are received by the county board no later than ten days after the election by 5:00 P.M.

c. The ballots are received in accordance with Article 21A of this Chapter or the Chapter.

<u>d.</u> The State Board or court order extended the closing time of the polls for every poll in the county in accordance with G.S. 163-166.25. If the
