HOUSE BILL DRH10586-NTe-12

Short Title: Even-Yr Elections/4-Yr Mayor Term/Belville. (Local)

Sponsors: Representative Iler.

Referred to:

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS IN THE TOWN OF BELVILLE  
3 BE CONDUCTED IN EVEN-NUMBERED YEARS AND TO INCREASE THE MAYOR'S  
4 TERM FROM TWO TO FOUR YEARS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 SECTION 1. Section 4 of the Charter of the Town of Belville, being Chapter 84 of  
7 the 1977 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

8 "Sec. 4. ~~The regular~~ Regular municipal election elections shall be held in November 1977,  
9 and biennially thereafter for the election of a mayor and the members of the board of  
10 commissioners in even-numbered years. The election shall be nonpartisan and decided by simple  
11 plurality and held at the time specified in G.S. 163-279(a)(1).

12 The municipal elections shall be held and conducted by the county board of elections and the  
13 town shall reimburse the county board of elections for the cost thereof except the first election  
14 required to be held herein thereof. The elections shall be conducted in accordance with the  
15 applicable provisions of Articles 23 and 24 of Chapter 163 of the General Statutes of North  
16 Carolina, except as otherwise provided herein."

17 SECTION 2. Section 5 of the Charter of the Town of Belville, being Chapter 84 of  
18 the 1977 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

19 "Sec. 5. ~~In the 1977 municipal election and biennially thereafter, the~~ The mayor shall be  
20 elected for a term of two four years. ~~In the 1977 municipal election the two candidates for~~  
21 ~~commissioner receiving the highest number of votes shall be elected for a term of four years, and~~  
22 ~~the two candidates receiving the next highest number of votes shall be elected for a term of two~~  
23 ~~years. Thereafter as the term of each member of the board of commissioners expires, his~~  
24 ~~successor shall be elected for a term of four years.~~ Members of the board of commissioners shall  
25 be elected for terms of four years on a staggered basis."

26 SECTION 3. No regular municipal elections shall be conducted in the Town of  
27 Belville in 2027. The terms of office of the mayor and members of the board of commissioners  
28 set to expire in 2027 shall be extended by one year. The terms of office of the members of the  
29 board of commissioners set to expire in 2029 shall be extended by one year. Beginning in 2028,  
30 municipal elections shall take place biennially in even-numbered years, pursuant to Section 1 of  
31 this act. Beginning in 2028, the mayor shall serve four-year terms, pursuant to Section 2 of this  
32 act.

33 SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to elections held  
34 on or after that date.
