- 1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 13-14, by rewriting those lines to read:
- 2 "SECTION 2. Notwithstanding Section 1 of this act, for purposes of the 2026 election
- 3 only, any candidate seeking nomination by petition for municipal office must file a petition with
- 4 the county board of elections no later than 12:00 noon on July 6, 2026. Except as otherwise
- 5 provided by this section, candidates shall comply with the requirements set out in Article 11 of
- 6 Chapter 163 of the General Statutes of North Carolina.
- 7 SECTION 3. Section 1 of this act becomes effective January 1, 2027, and applies to
- 8 elections held in 2028 and thereafter. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law
- 9 and applies to petitions filed on or after that date."
