1 moves to amend the bill on page 2, lines 36-38, by rewriting the lines to read:

3           "2. Is not owned or controlled by an entity formed in a foreign  
4 country or by a government of a foreign country, unless the  
5 entity meets at least one of the following criteria:

6           I. The entity has received a determination from the  
7 Committee of Foreign Investment in the United States  
8 (CFIUS) that there are no unresolved national security  
9 concerns with respect to the entity in connection to a  
10 matter submitted to CFIUS and which CFIUS  
11 concluded all action pursuant to Section 721 of the  
12 Defense Production Act of 1950, as amended.

13           II. The entity has a national security agreement with  
14 CFIUS and maintains the validity of the national  
15 security agreement.

16           III. The entity is a United States domiciled subsidiary of an  
17 entity that meets the criteria of sub-sub-subdivisions I.  
18 or II. of this sub-sub-subdivision.";

20 on page 3, lines 32-33, by rewriting the lines to read:

22           "(1) Terminate an account held by an account holder who is 14 or 15 years of age  
23 and who does not have a parent or guardian's consent after providing the  
24 account holder 30 days to dispute the termination.";

26 on page 5, lines 37-41, by rewriting the lines to read:

28           "(c) An internet service provider or its affiliates or subsidiaries, a search engine, a cloud  
29 service provider, a connected-device manufacturer or seller, or an operating-system developer or  
30 provider, does not violate this Chapter solely for manufacturing, selling, configuring, preloading,  
31 updating, securing, or providing access or connection to or from an addictive social media  
32 platform not under the provider's control, including transmission, downloading, intermediate



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1 storage, or access software, to the extent the provider is not otherwise an addictive social media  
2 platform.";

4 and on page 5, line 46, by rewriting the line to read:

6 "SECTION 1.(b) This section becomes effective January 1, 2027, and applies to  
7 causes of action arising on or after that date."
