- 6 and on page 3, lines 1-10, by rewriting the lines to read:
- 7 "SECTION 2.(b) The North Carolina Human Trafficking Commission
- 8 (Commission) shall conduct a study on human trafficking needs in the State, including
- 9 information on the development process for a statewide human trafficking reporting and response
- 10 system (system). After the Commission completed the study, the Commission is encouraged to
- 11 begin facilitating stakeholder collaboration on the development of a system that facilitates
- 12 referral to the National Human Trafficking hotline for crisis support as necessary. It is the intent
- 13 of the General Assembly to establish a system that will (i) notify law enforcement and child
- 14 protection officials of high priority reports, (ii) provide a secure dashboard for authorized
- 15 personnel to view, triage, and respond to reports, and (iii) support real-time communication
- 16 between investigators and survivors or reporters with consent."
