- The State Auditor's Office conducts financial audits, performance audits, information system audits, investigations, and special reports.

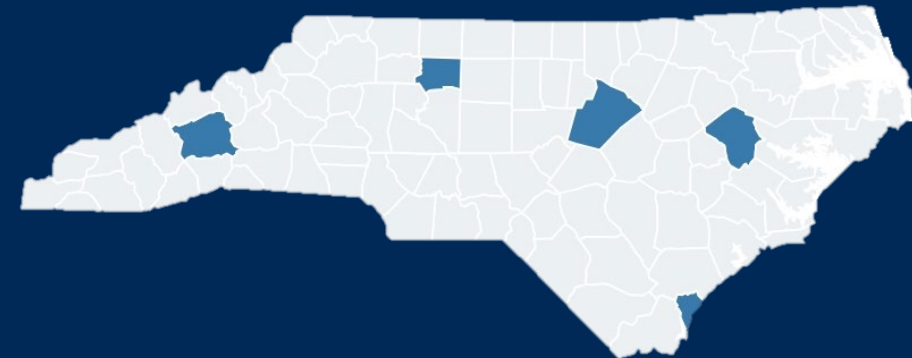
## OSA's audit responsibilities cover

- \$117 billion in state assets
- \$35 billion in federal grants
- Finances of public universities
- North Carolina community colleges
- State contracts
- Municipalities
- Nonprofits receiving public dollars

**Regional Offices:** OSA currently has five locations across North Carolina in Asheville, Kernersville, Raleigh, Wilmington, and Greenville.

## 206 full-time positions

- All vacancies from previous administration filled
- Hiring additional 45 FTEs given through DAVE Act

# Division of Accountability, Vision, and Efficiency



- DAVE Act included in House Bill 125 – Continuing Budget Operations.
- Requires all state agencies to detail vacant positions, lapsed salary, office space utilization, and mission by October 1.
- OSA will issue report in January on preliminary findings.
- Additional reports likely between now and division sunset in 2028.

- Provide data to better inform policy decisions.
- Monitor monies appropriated by the General Assembly.
- Hold state agencies and recipients of state money accountable.
- Inform of strengths and weaknesses in laws, procedures, and practices.
